Purpose: To offer a group of preteens/teens with similar communication targets an opportunity to further develop their social communication within a small group. Using concepts from Michelle Garcia Winner's curriculum and other social cognitive tools, the group members will work on developing their social thinking skills, problem solving skills, and conversation skills.
